He views Stewardship is a fundamental component of Christian discipleship. "On the personal level its about how we manage all that we have and all that we are in accordance with the self-giving, generous love of Christ, from the most intimate matters of our spiritual life to engagement with the structures of government for the sake of social justice and care of the earth. On the congregational level it's about organizational development, Christian Education, Worship and Mission . . . stewardship of what the apostle Paul refers to as the "mysteries of God." (I Cor. 4:1) In other words, stewardship is not just a matter of fundraising to meet the budget.
