1. The following are the committees of the Presbytery of Prospect Hill
 - a. Committee on Ministry/Committee on Preparation
 - b. Committee on Representation
 - c. Nominating Committee
 - d. Budget and Finance Committee
 - e. Permanent Judicial Committee
 - f. Bi-Presbytery Camp Council

2. Committee Membership

Unless otherwise specified each Committee shall:

- Have a chairperson nominated by the Committee on Nominations and elected yearly by Presbytery.
- Have three year terms, divided into three classes.
- Have members who serve full or partial terms aggregating not more than 6 years. (cf. Form of Government G-14.201a)
- Have at least one half of committee members laypersons, (cf. Form of Government G-9.0501)
- Work to become more open and inclusive and to correct patterns of discrimination on the basis of race, sex, age, or disability, (cf. Form of Government G-9.0104)
- Any member of a Presbytery Committee who is absent three consecutive meetings without requesting an excused absence shall be considered to have resigned and the position shall be filled as provided in 7.2 without further notice,
- Youth Members shall be defined as 25 years of age or younger.

All committee positions will be filled by the nominating committee with the exception of the nominating committee. The nominating committee shall be elected by the moderator team.
